APPEAL BOND \$ \_\_\_\_\_

PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY conveyed by Title 11 Section 27-129 of the Oklahoma Statute, this Order shall hereby set an appeal bond in the above styled case and give notice of Defendant's intent to file an appeal with the District Court of Oklahoma County.

- An appeal may be taken from any final decision of the Municipal Court.
- Bond shall be fixed by the Municipal Judge and shall be twice the amount of the fine plus court cost; however, the bond shall not be less than \$100 nor more than twice the amount of such fine. The appeal bond is set at \$\_\_\_\_\_. This bond will be payable in cash, money order or by credit card.
- Within ten (10) calendar days from the final decision, written Notice of Intent to Appeal must be filed in the District Court and a certified copy filed in the Municipal Court.
- Upon notice of appeal being filed, the required appeal bond shall be posted.
  - a. **FILING (District Court)** – The Notice of Intent to Appeal must be filed, in writing, with the District Court Clerk, located at the Oklahoma County Courthouse, 320 Robert S. Kerr Avenue, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.
  - b. **FILING (Edmond Municipal Court)** – After the appeal has been filed in District Court, within the same ten (10) calendar days, a certified copy must be filed in the Edmond Municipal Court along with the required appeal bond (amount listed above).
- After the appeal is filed, any questions should be directed to the District Court.
